Something to think about...  
**Attendance Statistics over One School Year**

98% = 4 days absent from school  
95% = 10 days absent from school  
90% = 4 weeks absent from school  
85% = 5 ½ weeks absent from school  
80% = 7 ½ weeks absent from school

**Attendance over 5 years (Y2- Y6)**  
85 - 90% = About half a year off school.  
80% = 38 weeks absent from school - one whole year of school missed!

Fact: the more time spent in school, the better your child's attainment.
