Information has previously been reported on the fines incurred for taking your child/children out of school, including on holiday, in term-time. Please note that the fine is for each child (£80 each) and for each parent (£80 each) for each child.

For example, if you take two children out of school parent 1 will be fined £160 and parent 2 will also be fined £160, totalling a £320 fine for the family.

This charge to parents is then doubled if children are taken out for a second time.
