Primary School Admissions - Reception Class Sept-25

Please see below the Admission details (BwDBC letter and poster) for parents of children starting Reception Class in September 2025, with an application deadline of 15th January 2025. All children need to apply to BwDBC, as below, to start in any School's Reception Class, even if they are currently enrolled in that school's or another Nursery.

Parking

Unless this has been previously agreed with the Headteacher in advance, please do not park in the school car park at any time when dropping off or picking up your children

Dinner and Breakfast Club Payments

DINNERS need paying for on the day or at the beginning of the week in cash or by online SCOPAY payment. If any debt becomes substantial we will have to consider stopping providing a school dinner to the child. BREAKFAST CLUB sessions are payable on the day or at the beginning of the week in cash or by online SCOPAY payment. If any debt becomes substantial we will have to consider stopping the child attending.

Holidays in Term Time

The Government have recently made some significant changes to the law in school term. Consequently, if you take your child out of school on holiday in the school term time the school will refer you to the Local Authority for a penalty notice.

Punctuality

Please can you ensure that the children are brought to school on time every day. The school day starts at 8:45am and children should be on the school site ready to line up with their class at this time every day. If you are late arriving at school, you need to bring your child to the front office and sign them into the Late Book. However regular lates are not acceptable.
