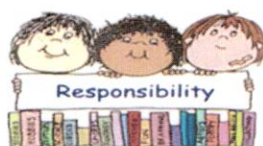

Dinner and Breakfast Club Payments

DINNERS: If your years 3, 4, 5 or 6 children are not eligible for Pupil Premium Free School Meals they will be charged £2.50 per school dinner. This need paying on the day or at the beginning of the week in cash or by online SCOPAY payment. If any debt becomes substantial we will have to consider stopping providing a school dinner to the child.

BREAKFAST CLUB: Payment for a session is payable on the day or at the beginning of the week in cash or by online SCOPAY payment. If any debt becomes substantial we will have to consider stopping the child attending the club.

Breakfast Club

Breakfast Club runs between Monday and Friday from 8:00am to 8:45am each morning. It costs £2 per session and includes food and drink.

If your children do not regularly attend our Breakfast Club and you want to put them into it please do not just turn up. You need to ring the Office at least the day beforehand to ensure that there are spaces available.

The Breakfast Club is now situated in our Nest Room which can be accessed from our Birley Street Gate and drop off is at the Nest door at the Nursery class playground.

Holidays in Term Time

The Government have recently made some significant changes to the law in school term. Consequently if you take your child out of school on holiday in the school term time the school will refer you to the Local Authority for a penalty notice.

Punctuality

Please can you ensure that the children are brought to school on time every day. The school day starts at 8:45am and children should be on the school site ready to line up with their class at this time every day. If you are late arriving at school you need to bring your child to the front office and sign them into the Late Book. However regular lates are not acceptable.

Parking

Unless this has been previously agreed with the Headteacher in advance please do not park in the school car park at any time when dropping off or picking up your children
